## Federal Law Enforcement Officers Assoc Excoriates Kentucky State Parole Board's Decision To Release Cop Killer

Lewisberry, PA – Today, FLEOA National President J. Adler announced that the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association has denounced the Kentucky State Parole Board's decision to release convicted cop killer, Timothy Doyle, prior to the completion of his full sentence. FLEOA vehemently opposes Doyle's release after ten years when he was sentenced to a 20 year sentence for his heinous crime.

According to Adler, "It is both presumptuous and unconscionable for the Kentucky State Parole Board to think they're capable of assessing the human condition of an inhuman cop killer. The Devil on his best behavior is still the Devil, and this murderer should serve his full 20 year sentence." When Doyle savagely murdered hero Investigator Brandon Thacker, he forfeited any right to be afforded leniency in his sentence.

While Investigator Thacker's loving family and the law enforcement community continues to mourn his loss, a murderer is going to be released back into the public at the end of the month. Is this how the state of Kentucky honors the sacrifices made by law enforcement officers who have died while dedicating their lives to maintaining law and order? FLEOA respectfully asks that Governor Beshear intervene and use his authority to ensure that this cop killer remains incarcerated to serve his full 20 year sentence. FLEOA'S 26,000 members are appealing to the governor to honor the memory of Investigator Thacker's sacrifice by doing the right thing.
